

**RECRUITMENT RALLY FOR GROUP ‘X’ (TECHNICAL) AND GROUP ‘Y’  
(MEDICAL ASSISTANT) TRADES  
AT GOVERNMENT ENGINEERING COLLEGE, MANGATTUPARAMBA,  
DHARAMSHALA, KANNUR (KERALA)  
BETWEEN 18 DECEMBER 2006 AND 22 DECEMBER 2006**

1. **Indian Air Force** offers opportunities for unmarried male Indian citizens from the designated districts of the State of Kerala to become an airman. The recruitment test for **Group ‘X’ (Technical)** and **Group ‘Y’ (Medical Assistant)** trades will be held between **18 December 2006** and **22 December 2006** at **Government Engineering College, Mangattuparamba, Dharamshala, Kannur (Kerala)** as per the Selection Programme given below at paragraph 2.

2. **SELECTION PROGRAMME:** The Recruitment Test will be conducted from **7 AM** onwards every day as per the details given below. Candidates reporting up to **10 AM** at the Rally Venue will only be permitted to appear in the Recruitment Test.

**ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**

3. **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:** -

(a) **For Group ‘X’ (Technical) Trades:** Candidate should have passed Intermediate/10+2/Equivalent examination with **Mathematics, Physics** and **English** with a minimum of **50%** marks in aggregate.

**OR**

Three years Diploma in Engineering (**Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics/Automobile/Computer Science/Instrumentation Technology/Information Technology**) with 50% marks from a Govt. recognised Polytechnic/ Institute.

(b) **For Group 'Y' (Medical Assistant) Trade** : Candidate should have passed Intermediate/10+2/Equivalent Examination with Chemistry, Biology and English with a minimum of **50%** marks in aggregate.

**Note**: - Exact aggregate percentage of marks up to first place of decimal for all subjects as mentioned in the Marks Sheet of Intermediate/10+2/Equivalent Board Examination/ Diploma in Engineering only to be counted for calculating the percentage. For example, 49.9% should **NOT** be rounded off to 50%.

**4. President Central Airmen Selection Board reserves the right to shortlist the applications on the basis of available vacancies and number of eligible applicants.**

**5. AGE LIMIT**:- Candidate should be born between **01 January 1986** and **31 March 1990** (both days inclusive)

**6. MEDICAL STANDARDS** (a) **Height**: Minimum acceptable height is 152.5 cm (b) **Chest**: Minimum range of expansion : 5 cm (c) **Weight**: Proportionate to height and age (d) **Vision**: Minimum Visual Standard: Unaided 6/36, corrected to at least 6/9 each eye with spectacles, Dioptric power not exceeding  $\pm 3.5$  Dioptres in any axis. Full field of vision and Defective safe colour vision CP-II/III. (**Candidates should bring latest prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if used**) (e) **Corneal Surgery** (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable. (f) **Hearing**: Candidates should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters with each ear separately. (g) **Dental**: Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points. (h) **Health**: Candidates should be free from medical or surgical deformity. He should be free from all communicable diseases and skin ailments. Candidates must be physically and mentally **FIT** to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain.

**7. Candidates who have been discharged from the Indian Air Force for any reason earlier are not eligible to appear in the rally.**

**8. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED** : Candidates are to bring the following documents along with them while coming for the examination:-

(a) Seven copies of recent (**not older than three months**) passport-size **colour photograph** (front portrait, without headgear except for Sikhs). Photographs should be only on good quality "photo paper". **Change in physical appearance with photograph is not admissible at the time of reporting at rally venue for test** (b) Two unstamped self addressed **24x10 cm white envelopes** of good quality. (c) All **original** educational as well as NCC certificates (if applicable) and mark sheets with **three attested** photostat copies of each. (d) To be eligible to appear in the rally at **Government Engineering College, Mangattuparamba, Dharamshala, Kannur (Kerala)** the candidates must

have passed the qualifying examination from the recognized Boards from the **State of Kerala (From Districts as designated in paragraph 2)** or should fulfill the domicile requirements as applicable to the **State of Kerala (Districts as designated in paragraph 2) (Domicile Certificate issued by Village Officer, Tehsildar, District Collector or any official authorized by the State Government of Kerala only will be accepted)**. (e) Sons of Army, Navy, DSC, MES and Central Paramilitary Forces {i.e. Assam Rifles, ITBP, BSF, GREF, KV Staff, LAO and Territorial Army (only Service combatants)} personnel posted at units located in the **specified districts of Kerala as mentioned in Para 2** are also eligible **subject to production of requisite certificate from the concerned Head of the Department** (f) Sons of Serving/Retired/Discharged/Deceased Air Force Personnel, irrespective of their domicile status may be permitted to appear in the rally subject to submission of Son of Air Force Personnel Certificate as a proof in the following categories:- (i) Father/Mother is presently serving in any Air Force Unit located in the **specified districts of Kerala as mentioned in Para 2** (ii) Ex-IAF personnel/families of deceased personnel who are residing in the **specified districts of Kerala as mentioned in Para 2 (on production of proof of minimum stay of one year)**.

(iii) Original and one attested copy of discharge book. (g) Those who are below 18 years of age are to get the consent form (given below) filled and signed by their parent/guardian. The candidates of 18 years of age and above can sign the consent form themselves. Candidates are to bring the “Consent Form” to the Examination Venue and submit the same before the Physical Fitness Test.

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**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

9. **TENURE & TRAINING**: Enrolment is for an initial period of 20 years extendable up to the age of 57 years. Initially candidates will be sent for a Joint Basic

Phase Training (JBPT) for 12 weeks at ATS Belgaum (Karnataka). On successful completion of JBPT, candidates will be allocated trades and sent for trade training of specified durations. Training is however liable to be terminated at any time if the trainee fails to achieve the required standards in academics, profession, physical fitness and discipline or is found to be medically unfit.

**10. PAY & ALLOWANCES:** During training a stipend of **Rs.2,850/- pm** will be paid. On completion of training, starting gross emoluments at the minimum of scale of pay for **Group 'X' (Technical)** trades will be **Rs.6,900/- pm** (approximately) and for **Group 'Y' (Medical Assistant)** trade will be **Rs.6,100/- pm** (approximately) which, in subsequent years, may rise up to **Rs.13,800/- pm** (approximately) for **Group 'X' (Technical)** trades and **Rs.12,600/- pm** (approximately) for **Group 'Y' (Medical Assistant)** trade depending upon the rank attained.

**11. PROMOTION:** Promotion prospects exist up to the rank of Master Warrant Officer (MWO). Opportunities for promotion to Commissioned Officers also exist for those who qualify the prescribed examinations.

### **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

**12. VERIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY:** Original Certificates/Mark Sheets and other required documents will be scrutinized and verified at the examination venue on the rally day before the commencement of written test.

### **SEQUENCE OF EXAMINATION**

13. Written test will be objective type and question paper will be bilingual (English & Hindi) except English Paper. Duration of written test will be 60 minutes for both Group 'X' (Technical) and Group 'Y' (Medical Assistant) trades. Written test will be based on CBSE upto Class XII syllabus.

**14. WRITTEN TEST:** Written test will be conducted as follows:-

**(i) For Group 'X' (Technical) Trades : English, Physics & Mathematics**

**(ii) For Group 'Y' (Medical Assistant) Trade : English, Chemistry & Biology**

Result of the written test will be declared on the same day and successful candidates will undertake **Physical Fitness Test (PFT)** on the same or next day.

**15. PHYSICAL FITNESS TEST (PFT) :** PFT consists of a **1.6 Km** run to be completed within **8 minutes**. Candidates completing the PFT **in less than 7 minutes 30 seconds** will be awarded additional marks on a sliding scale. Candidates are advised to bring their **sports shoes and shorts**.

**16. INTERVIEW:** Candidates who have passed the written test and PFT will be interviewed. Candidates who qualify interview will be medically examined.

**17. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:** Medical Examination will be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards.

**NOTE: candidates are advised to get tartar & stains removed from their teeth before appearing for the written test. Ears to be free of wax. Candidates should be prepared to stay for four to five days for which they have to make their own arrangements. No TA/DA will be admissible.**
