1. Applications are invited from sportsmen/women who have made the following achievements in sports/games disciplines shown in Annexure 1 during the calendar years 1997 to 2001 for appointment in the State Government Service under the scheme for the Appointment of outstanding sportsmen/women in Public Service:-

(i) Those who were members of the team which represented the country in International Competitions conducted by recognized International Federations viz, Olympics, World Cup, Asian Games, Common Wealth Games, Universiad, Asian championships and other International Competitions cleared by the Government of India and in which a minimum of five countries having good standard participate and won first, second or third position in individual or team events.

(ii) Those who have represented the country in International Competitions

(iii) Those who were members of the Kerala State team which participated in approved National Championships in the Senior (men/women) division, conducted by approved national Sports Federation/Association and won first, second or third place in individual events or were placed in first or second position in team events

(iv) Those who were members of the University team of any of the universities in Kerala which participated in the All India Interuniversity competitions and won first or second places in individual events or were placed in first place in team events

Note:- (a) Only achievements in Olympics item or Sports and Games and such of non Olympics items recognized by the Kerala Sports Council will be taken into account for giving employment

(b) The order of priority and other guidelines for selection of candidates will be those state in the Annexure IV of this Notification.

## **2. Selection Procedure**

- 2.1 The selection of the candidates for appointment will be made purely on the basis of achievements in the field of sports/games as given above.
- 2.2 *Number of vacancies:-* The present selection is for 100 vacancies which are pending appointments for the years from 1997 to 2001 and the appointments will be done on the basis of the vacancies apportioned among various disciplines as shown in Annexure 1.
- 2.3 Approved World Competitions mean the competitions organized by the International Apex bodies of the concerned disciplines and in which the national teams are sponsored by the National Apex bodies and cleared by the Sports Authority of India/Government of India.
- 2.4 The National Championship means the Championships conducted by the National Apex body of the concerned disciplines once in a year.
- 2.5 Individual Game/event means a game/event in which an individual performs alone. Individual events is one in which the achievement is the result of the contribution by one individual as participant and team event is one in which the achievement is the result of contribution of more than one individuals as participants
- 2.6 Representing the State in the zonal/cluster level competitions which is part of the National Competitions, shall be treated equal to participation in National competition representing the State.
- 2.7 When a candidate has a number of achievements in different disciplines, his/her best achievements will be considered for appointment.
- 2.8 The achievements made in the field of sports for the calendar years 1997 to 2001 alone will be considered for appointment.
- 2.9 All competitions where an upper age limit is fixed would be treated as junior event provided the concerned national Federation does not classify it as a Senior event.
- 2.10 If a candidate represents the Indian University team in the National Championship for men/women, he/she shall be considered for the benefit of the norms only if he/she was a student in one of the Universities in Kerala during the year of representation.
- 2.11 When there is a tie in any of the achievements listed above, the following criteria in the priority listed will be applied to break the tie;

(a) Individual achievements will be ranked above team achievements.

(b) If a new record is created he/she will be given next priority.

(c) If the participants from two age group competitions tie, then participant in the age group with the upper age limit will get priority.

(d) Captaincy in the higher competition will be given the next place.

(e) If there is still a tie a candidate who have achievements in other disciplines will be preferred to a candidate who have achievements only in one discipline.

(f) If tie cannot be broken by any of the above mentioned sports achievements the University marks in the subjects in the qualifying examinations will be the basis for breaking the tie.

2.12 The selection will be made by a Committee constituted by the Government for the purpose.

2.13 The candidates so selected and recommended for employment by the Selection Committee may be appointed against the posts listed in Annexure II subjects to their suitability with reference to their qualifications prescribed for the posts.

2.14 The Government may on the recommendations of the Committee restrict the number of candidates to be selected under each discipline of Sports/Games.

2.15 The Government shall determine on the advice of the Committee, whether active sports persons or those who have retired from active sports career or both should be selected during a year, the number to be selected in each category and the departments and posts in which they should be appointed.

2.16 Interview of the candidates may be conducted, if found necessary by the Committee

2.17 The selected candidates for each category of post shall be ranked in the order of merit for allotment and appointments.

### **3. Instructions to candidates and General Conditions**

3.1 *Application and Identification forms:-* candidates should apply in the format appended as Annexure III typed on white plain paper of foolscap size. The application should be filled up in the candidates own handwriting dated and signed by him/her. The Identification form in Annexure III (a) should be duly filled up by the candidates dated and signed and authenticated by the identifying Officer who should be a Gazetted Government Officer. The candidates, who are already employed, should send their applications through their employers. However, if delay is anticipated, an advance copy of application may be sent.

3.2 Enclosures;- The following enclosures should be firmly stitched along with the application form:-

(i) Copies of documents to prove education qualifications and experience.

(ii) Copies of documents in support of age and date of birth

(iii) Copies of documents obtained from the concerned Sports Organizations which conducted the Championship to prove the achievements in Sports mentioned in paragraph 1 of this Notification. Certificates issued by any other Association/Organization will not be accepted. The certificates should be arranged chronologically and in the order of priority shown in Annexure IV.

(iv) Two copies of the recent passport size photograph of the candidates one pasted and signed by the candidates on the application form and the other with the identification certificate [prescribed in Annexure III (a)] duly attested by a Gazetted Government Officer.

(v) Copy of the Certificates from the competent authority in the case of the candidates for whom relaxation of age limit is admissible.

(vi) Identification Certificate [in the prescribed format-with the application in Annexure III (a)]

3.3 All the copies of the documents sent along with the application should be self attested

3.4. *Whom to address:-* The application complete in all respects along with its enclosures should be sent in envelopes super scribed with the name of the post addressed to

3.5 The candidates may apply for any of the posts given in Annexure II, provided they satisfy the qualification prescribed for that post. A candidate, who wishes to apply for more than one post, need not send separate applications. They can apply for any post in one application stating their order of preference.

3.6 Last date:- The last date for receipt of the application in the Office of the Principal Secretary to Government, General Administration (Service D) Department, Thiruvananthapuram is 25-2-2004 at 4.00 pm Belated applications will not be considered.

3.7 *Invalid Applications:-*

(a) The application having the following defects/irregularities will summarily be rejected

(i) Incomplete or illegible

(ii) Unsigned

(iii) Without the requisite number of photograph and enclosures

(iv) Unattested copies of documents

(v) Identification Certificates not properly authenticate

(b) The candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility criteria and that the particulars furnished by him/her are correct in all aspects.

3.8 *Age:-* The candidates should complete 18 years of age and should not have completed 35 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2003. However, usual relaxation of the upper age limit prescribed under rule 10 (c) of General Rules of Kerala State & Subordinate Service Rules 1958 will be available for Scheduled Castes/scheduled tribes and Other Backward Classes.

#### **4. Appointment**

- 4.1 The selected sports persons who wish to pursue sports will be appointed against the supernumerary posts to be created to accommodate them in departments. They shall be absorbed against regular posts in the departments on retirements from active sports.
- 4.2 The selected sports persons who wish to retire from active sports or have already retired from active sports shall be straightway appointed against regular posts.
- 4.3 Canvassing of any form will be a disqualification for appointment.
