- 1) Diploma in Railway Transport and Management or Diploma in Transport Economics or Diploma in Multi Modal Transport (Containerisation) and Logistics Management awarded by Institute of Rail Transport will be an additional desirable qualification for Cats. 101 to 106, 201, 202 & 301 of RRB/Chennai and Cats. 1 & 4 of RRB/Trivandrum.

- 3) Second stage examination for Cats. 101 to 105 may be conducted online (computerised). Candidates should possess basic computer skills.
- 4) Final allotment to Cats. 101, 102 and 103 will be based on the merit position of the candidates. Candidates securing higher merit position will be considered for Traffic Apprentice, Commercial Apprentice and Section Controller. Final allotment to Cat. 107 and Cat. 2 will be based on the merit position of the candidates. Candidates securing higher merit position will be considered for Commercial Clerk.
- 5) For Cats. 11 to 23, other qualification including Diploma in Engineering will not be accepted on the ground of being higher qualification in the same line of trade.

SPECIAL NOTES

1. Vacancies for RRB/CHENNAI & RRB/TRIVANDRUM have been indicated separately. For Category Nos. 101 to 402, applications must be sent to RRB/Chennai. However, candidates are required to send in separate applications to RRB/Trivandrum (RRB/TVC) for Category Nos. 1 to 23 as RRB/TVC will be separately processing and finalizing panels for the vacancies for these posts.

1.1 Candidates applying for Cat Nos. (i) 101 to 106 (ii) 107 to 110 (iii) 201 & 202 and (iv) 304 & 305 (v) 2 & 3 need fill in only one application for each group clearly indicating their order of preference of categories and posts applied for. Final allotment to posts will be made depending on merit, vacancies available and preference of the candidate. If no preference is indicated by the candidate, RRB's decision regarding preference for Category will be final.

1.2 For Categories 302, 304 and 305 of RRB/Chennai and 9 to 23 of RRB/Trivandrum, Course Completed Act Apprentices trained in the Railway Establishment shall be given preference over a candidate who is not such an apprentice. Upper age limit for the Course Completed Act Apprentice will be 35 years if he/she had commenced Act Apprenticeship under the Apprenticeship Act before attaining the age of 25 years. In addition the candidates belonging to OBC and SC/ST are eligible for normal relaxation of 3 and 5 years respectively.

1.2.1 For Categories 401 and 6, candidates will be required to qualify in a Stenography Skill Test at a speed of 80 w.p.m. in English after passing written examination.

1.2.2 For categories 5 & 8, candidates will be required to qualify in a Typing Test at a speed of 30 w.p.m. in English or 25 w.p.m. in Hindi.

2.0 **Recruitment Process:** After scrutiny of the applications, RRB will issue call letters for written examination to eligible applicants indicating the time, date and venue. The cities / towns where the written examinations are to be held will be as per the administrative convenience of RRB/Chennai & RRB/Trivandrum

NOTE: The examination may be held for the same posts in more than one RRB on the same day. It is possible that written examination is scheduled on the same day for more than one post for which the candidate has applied to the same RRB or other RRBs on the Indian Railways.

2.1 **Written Examination:** Question paper will be in bi-lingual i.e. English/Hindi. Question Paper for Cat No. 401 & Cat No. 6 will be in English only. Duration of the exam will be 1 1/2 to 2 hours with approximately 100-125 questions with negative marking. 1 mark will be deducted for every 3 wrong answers.

2.1.1 **Syllabus for Written Examination:** Written examination will consist of objective type questions to test the candidates knowledge in the subjects specified as part of minimum educational qualification for the post, analytical and quantitative skills and General Knowledge. Approximately 50% of questions will be to test the candidates' knowledge of the prescribed Professional Qualification (Technical Subjects). 50% of questions on Mathematics, General Knowledge and Test of Reasoning. However, these are only broad indications and decision of RRB in this regard is final.

2.1.2 **Ability Test:** There will be aptitude test for the post of Prob. ASM & Asst. Loco Pilot. This will be of qualifying nature. Performance in written exam and aptitude test will be taken into consideration at the time of empanelment.

2.2 **Verification:** Finally, the candidates will be called to the office of the respective Railway Recruitment Boards for verification of all certificates and counselling before recommending them for appointment.

2.3 **Panel:** A panel of successful candidates will be recommended to the Railway Administration who will in turn verify all original documents and issue appointment order subject to the candidate fulfilling all the criteria including medical standards against vacancies.

2.3.1 Mere selection of candidates or recommendation of his/her name by the Railway Recruitment Board for appointment does not confer any right on the candidate for his/her appointment in Railways.

Please Note: Railway Recruitment Boards reserve the right to conduct additional / second stage / re-examination and/or interviews/verification at any stage. RRB also reserves the right to cancel part or whole of any recruitment process at any stage for any of the categories notified without assigning any reason thereof.

3.0 GENERAL CONDITIONS OF RECRUITMENT:

3.1 The number of vacancies indicated is provisional and may increase or decrease and even become 'Nil' depending upon the actual needs of the Administration. The Administration also reserves the right to cancel all notified vacancies at its discretion and such

decision will be final and binding on all. In the event of cancellation of the notified vacancies, the examination fee/postal charge paid by the candidates will not be refunded.

3.2 Before applying for the post, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils all the eligibility norms including the community requirements of the post. The candidate should have the requisite educational/technical qualifications from the recognized Universities/Institutions and should enclose attested Photostat copies as proof of the same at the time of sending the application.

At the time of applying, candidates should possess the prescribed minimum Educational Qualification. Final / Provisional certificates issued by the competent authorities along with copies of all mark sheets only will be considered. Those awaiting results of the final examination or the qualifying certificates need not apply.

3.3 Candidates trying to use influence or unfair means will be disqualified from selection at any stage. 3.4.1 **Details of medical standards:** Details and criteria given above are indicative and not exhaustive. Other tests as required will also be included.

3.4.2 **Candidates who do not fulfill the prescribed medical standards need not apply.**

3.4.3 **Candidates should enclose medical certificate in the prescribed format for categories 106 (A-2 Fitness), 302 (A-1 Fitness) and 9 (A-1 Fitness) along with their application.**

3.5 Selected candidates will be required to execute a bond and agree to serve the Railway Administration for a prescribed period.

3.6 Selected candidates who are finally appointed are liable for active service in the Railway Engineers Unit of Territorial Army.

3.7 Candidates recommended for Southern Railway are liable to be posted and transferred to any place within the jurisdiction of Southern Railway.

4.0 SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

4.1 The recruitment process is subject to caste based reservation.

4.1.1 All candidates irrespective of community will be considered for

UR vacancy subject to their fulfilling the age criteria for UR vacancies. However, against specific community quota, only candidates of that particular community will be considered. Please note

• Caste certificate from competent authority for SC/ST and OBC candidates in the prescribed format has to be produced.

• If the candidates belong to and wish to be considered against a specific community quota and tick the community column accordingly, their application will be rejected if proof of community in the prescribed format is not enclosed.

• Any subsequent representation for change of community status will not be entertained under any circumstances.

4.1.2 OBC candidates should specifically obtain a certificate to the effect that the candidate does not belong to persons/sections (Creamy Layer) mentioned in Column 3 of the Schedule to the Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training OM NO.36012/22/93-Est (SCT), dated 8.9.1993. Unless this criteria is satisfied, OBC candidates cannot avail of the reservation under this quota and if they have indicated the community as OBC their application will be rejected and they will not be considered even against unreserved quota. The certificate should not be more than one year old. (Please refer the prescribed format shown as ANNEXURE-1)

4.1.3 OBC candidates are required to fill a separate Declaration as mentioned at Annexure-2.

4.1.4 OBC candidates not possessing "Non Creamy Layer" Certificate may apply under UR Quota (if available) subject to fulfilling UR age limit duly ticking the UR column.

4.2 **Travel concession:** Free second class sleeper pass will be issued to the candidates belonging to SC & ST community whenever they are called by RRB/Chennai or RRB/TVC during any stage of selection. Candidates must however indicate the nearest Railway station in English in the Application Form.

4.3 **Special Age Relaxation:** Special age relaxation is available to some groups of candidates as indicated below: Candidates desirous of availing age relaxation should indicate the corresponding code in the application form in the space provided. Documentary proof should also be enclosed.

4.3.1 No age relaxation is allowed to SC/ST/OBC candidates applying against Unreserved posts. Even if they qualify for such posts where only UR vacancies exist, they will be rejected on age grounds if they do not fulfil the UR age criteria. In the same way if SC/ST/OBC candidates qualify in the UR merit list but

they do not fulfil the UR age criteria, they will be adjusted against their respective quota vacancies, if available.

4.8 Andaman & Nicobar Candidates: Candidates belonging to Andaman & Nicobar Islands may be allotted examination center at Port Blair provided sufficient number of eligible candidates apply. Such candidates should enclose a certificate of domicile in Andaman & Nicobar Islands from a competent officer of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration or a certificate from the School/College last attended in Andaman & Nicobar certifying that the candidate had passed his/her examination from the School/College situated in Andaman & Nicobar.
