## ORDER

As per the Government order read above, modified rules were issued for granting accreditation to persons representing newspapers, news agencies, visual, audio and other electronics media institutions transmitting information.

- 2) The State Media Accreditation Committee, as per the minutes read above, recommended that for granting/renewal of accreditation of media persons working in the State from newspapers being published outside the State and if there is only one person in its bureau, the applicant can furnish recommendation letter/certificate from the next higher officer in his institution instead of letter from the bureau chief.
- 3) Government having examined the recommendation, are pleased to amend the Rules for accreditation issued vide the Government order read above as follows:

In Rule 2, after item 8 under the heading 'Relevant documents to be furnished for accreditation, the following is inserted as 9.

"9. For granting/renewal of accreditation of media persons working in the State from newspapers being published outside the State, if there is only one person in the bureau, the applicant can furnish recommendation letter/certificate from the next higher officer in his institution instead of letter from the bureau chief'.
